VENUE

The National Championships are being held in Richmond, NSW.

DATE

The Nationals will commence with registration day on Friday 8th July 2005 Banquet to be held on the Saturday 9th July at The Richmond Club, Cnr Francis & East Market Street, Richmond 2753.
 Conclude on the Thursday 14th July 2005.

ENTRIES

1. Entries will only be accepted on the official entry form. Or photocopy.
2. **In team events, each team member must pay an entry fee. Also, every competitor and team member must pay an administration fee and be members of the MAAA.** All members assisting, as a mechanic/caller in events not listed as a Team Event must be current MAAA member.
3. A junior is a person whose 18th birthday falls on or after 1st January 2005
4. Normal administration and entry fees will be paid for entries post-marked up to 6th June 05.
5. Late entries will be accepted until 5.00pm on registration day. **Late Penalty – Double Administration fee shall apply.**
6. A receipt will be sent out close to the Nationals with a location map of the Registration Centre.
7. Refunds of entry will be made up to 30th June 05. Thereafter refunds will be at the discretion of the Nationals Committee.

RULES

The rules to be used are those approved at the 2001 Council Conference and including postal votes approved to the 30th June 2001 and the M.A.S. Inc published rules for unofficial events. The FAI Sporting Code for International Rules as effective from January 2004 plus "Safety Rules advised by the F.A.I. shall also be put into affect"

AUS Number must be shown on aircraft, excluding scale models. The four top place getters will have their models processed immediately after the events. R.C. Pylon engines will be processed at this time.

In R.C. Aerobatics and Helicopter – A competitor may Only enter in the one class.
 A single aircraft may only be flown by one competitor in any event. Competitors who arrive late will miss out on all completed rounds of the contest.

- F5B Electric Glider will also include a special prize for models with a limited number of cells. (i.e. for 7 or 10 cells)
- 7 Cell Glider – Group Scoring will be used.
- BAD SPORTSMANSHIP will not be tolerated.

- R/C Pylon Events – Please provide details of callers/mechanics for all pylon events although they are only classified as TEAM MEMBERS for F3D & F5D.
- **Note Control Line Aerobatics** – Advanced level Competitors may if they wish also enter Expert level junior level competitors may also enter Advanced and Expert level or Novice. Novice Aerobatics are reserved for those competitors who are unable to complete the full F2B Pattern. This does not include square manouvers or triangular manouvers..

REGISTRATION DAY

The Registration Centre will be held at the Hawkesbury Indoor Stadium, 16 Stewart Street South Windsor NSW 2756. (Entry off Greenhills Way).

A location map will be sent out with Registration receipts and will also be available from the Tourist Information Centre, Phone 02 4588-5895.

Briefing at 7.30pm 8th July 2005, at the Administration Centre. All contestants must attend.

All CL racing and speed and RC pylon models will be processed at the Administration Centre on registration Day only. It is the competitors' responsibility to ensure that their models are available for processing on that day.

Scale Static judging will take place at the Registration Centre:

All Free Flight Scale aircraft on Saturday 9th July 9am-5pm.

All R/C Scale aircraft on Monday 11th July 9am-5pm.

Glider winches will be tested on Registration Day.

Only those radio frequencies approved by the MAAA will be allowed.

Transmitter checks will be performed on registration day at the Administration Centre. All transmitters must be checked and must be certified

Current FAI licences must be shown on registration day. or a current (05-06) receipt from your Club Secretary. Entrants **must** present permits to fly for models over 7 kilograms.

NOISE LEVELS

Normal EPA requirements will apply in areas close to residential areas.
