Please note that due to RAAF requirements with regard to available height clearances and the proximity of two excellent fields the Nats Committee has to advise that **Radio Frequencies will be split** as per the MAAA RULES BOOK PP 2-11, Paragraph 1.2.4, for the following events:

FREQUENCIES: 29.885 MHz and up. 36.300 MHz and up. 40.695 MHz and up.
EVENTS: F 400 PYLON. Q M PYLON. Q 500 PYLON. F 3 D PYLON. F 5 D PYLON.
F 3 J GLIDER. F 5 B ELECTRIC. 7 CELL GLIDER.

FREQUENCIES :29.865 MHz and down.36.290 MHz and down. 40.665 MHz and down..
EVENTS: F 3 B GLIDER. THERMAL GLIDER. JUNIOR THERMAL GLIDER. RC HAND LAUNCHED GLIDER. F 4 C SCALE. LARGE SCALE.

Due to this late change we are extending the **closing date** for entries until the **6th June 2005**.
All radio sets as presented for checking at the Registration Centre **must be certified**.

REGISTRATION: 9am -6pm Friday 8th July 2005, at the Hawkesbury Indoor Stadium, 16 Stewart Street South Windsor NSW 2756. (entry off Greenhills Way). Please remember to bring your valid FAI Card or a current (05-06) receipt from your club secretary. "Goodies Bags" containing a complete Program of events with entrants list , field location maps and a metal badge, cloth patch and decal, will be given to each entrant.

PROCESSING: All **CL** Racing Aircraft and **RC** Old Timer Aircraft that are required to be processed will be processed at the Registration Centre, address as above between 10am and 5pm Friday 8th July 2005. Please make sure you bring your plans as "proof" where required. **Pylon** aircraft which place 1st through 4th will be processed on the field at the conclusion of that event.

Scale static judging will take place at the Registration Centre: All **Free Flight Scale** aircraft on Saturday 9th July 9am - 5pm. **All RC Scale** aircraft on Monday 11th July 9am - 5pm.

CONTESTANTS BRIEFING: A contestants briefing will take place at the Registration Centre commencing at 7.30pm Friday the 8th July.

BANQUET SATURDAY NIGHT AT THE RICHMOND CLUB. A very limited number of tickets will be available at the Registration Centre . These will be sold on a first in basis , so you should order your tickets with your entry to avoid disappointment .

MECA COLLECTO and SWAP MEET at the Registration Centre . Collecto starting at 4pm and Swap Meet starting at 6pm on Wednesday the 13th July 2005.

FIELDS:

RC field 1 to be used for Old Timer, Texaco, and 38 Antique is the RAAF Drop Zone off Nutt Road Londonderry, approx 5klms South of Richmond.

RC field 2 to be used for Pylon and RC Scale is the Rickaby's Creek Base field off Percival Street Clarendon, approx 4klms East of Richmond.

RC field 3 to be used for Aerobatics and Helicopter is the Blacktown Radio Club field off Doonside Road at Doonside, approx 23 klms South East of Richmond.

RC field 4 to be used for Thermal Glider and Electric events is the ABC Turf Farm off Freeman's Reach Road at Freeman's Reach (near Gorricks Lane) approx 10 klms by road from Richmond.

RC field 5 to be used for practice and or as a reserve field is the HMAS club field off Londonderry Road at Richmond.

Free Flight will be held at the NSWFFS site off Cornwallis Road at Richmond Lowlands approx 3 klms North of Richmond.

Control Line grass events will be held at the Bensons Lane Sports Complex off Bensons Lane Richmond Lowlands, approx 2klms North of Richmond. Hard stand events will be held at the Penrith Regatta Centre off Castlereagh Road, Castlereagh, approx 16 klms South West of Richmond.

Indoor events will all be held at the Hawkesbury Indoor Stadium (Registration Centre) off Stewart Street at South Windsor, approx 5klms South East of Richmond.
