

Annex C MAAA Registrar's Report 2017

As of the 08 May 2017, the membership numbers for the 2016/17 year stood at a **total of 9554**, made up of 8831 Full Year Seniors, 281 Half Year Seniors, 375 Full Year Juniors, 52 Half Year Juniors, and 19 Life Members. These numbers suggest that by the end of the 2016/17 year, MAAA will have a drop in overall membership numbers by approximately 400. The current take up of renewals is just on 94.67% and new members joining, 910 are consistent with recent years. The breakdown is that the membership grew by 13% however the retention rate dropped by 19%, producing a reduction. The full details and facts will be presented in the Forum on Membership.

All cards are printed by the MAAA Registrar and then sent to the various State Associations for distribution to the members. In all cases, the membership renewals were processed and cards posted back to the State on the same day or the following day if received overnight. A new supply of cards was purchased to complete the 2016/17 membership period. Tax Invoices for membership are raised through MYOB on line, 391 have been raised to date and sent to the State Associations.

Honorary Membership

Thirteen Honorary Membership cards have been distributed to international visitors so far during the current year and records of these are held by the MAAA Registrar.

New State Registrars

In 2016/17 one new State Registrar was introduced to the MAAA Membership System.
